By registering for RISKWORLD 2026 (the Event), you hereby acknowledge and agree that you have read, understand, and will comply with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

If you are registering on behalf of another individual, it is your responsibility to ensure the person participating is aware of these terms and accepts them. By completing the registration on behalf of another individual you are warranting that you have made the Participant aware of these terms and that they have accepted these terms listed below.

- 1. RIMS Event Waiver and Release** - On behalf of myself and my personal representatives, I hereby release and indemnify RIMS (including but not limited to their board, agents, servants, representatives, employees, subsidiaries, affiliates, partners, predecessors, successors, assigns, insurers, and all persons, natural or corporate, in privity with any of them), and all of RIMS past, present and future officers, directors, servants, representatives, employees, subsidiaries, affiliates, partners, predecessors, successors and assigns, and all persons, natural or corporate, in privity with any of them (all collectively referred to as "**Released Parties**") from any and all liability and claims or causes of action of any kind whatsoever, whether based in contract, tort, regulation, at common law or by statute for property damage, personal injury, or death that may arise while participating in the described Activity or Program, it being intended by the parties hereto that all claims of any kind or character are released.

THE RELEASES AND INDEMNITIES STATED IN THIS AGREEMENT ARE SPECIFICALLY INTENDED TO OPERATE AND BE APPLICABLE EVEN IF IT IS ALLEGED OR PROVED THAT ALL OR SOME OF THE DAMAGES BEING SOUGHT WERE CAUSED AS A WHOLE OR IN PART BY ANY ACT, OMISSION, NEGLIGENCE, GROSS NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, INTENTIONAL CONDUCT, VIOLATION OF STATUTE OR COMMON LAW, BREACH OF WARRANTY, PRODUCT DEFECT, STRICT LIABILITY, OR ANY OTHER CONDUCT WHATSOEVER OF RIMS, ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AND REPRESENTATIVES.

Attendee assumes all risks and accepts sole responsibility for any injury (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that attendee may experience or incur in connection with attending RISKWORLD. Attendee hereby releases, covenants not to sue, discharges, and holds harmless RIMS, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from any such claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs, or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto.

Specifically relating to the global COVID-19 pandemic, the attendee acknowledges the highly contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assumes the risk of exposure or infection by attending the RISKWORLD 2026, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, disability, and/or death to the attendee. Attendee understands that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at RISKWORLD 2026 may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of others who may attend the event or their families, colleagues, or others with whom they may have contact. Accordingly, the attendee understands and agrees that this release includes any claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of RIMS, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in RISKWORLD 2026.

In addition to all other rules and regulations relating to the attendee's attendance at RISKWORLD 2026, attendee agrees to comply with all COVID-related procedures that may be implemented by RIMS and Pennsylvania Convention Center, including, but not limited to, mask-wearing and social distancing

requirements and restrictions on certain activities that carry higher COVID-related risk, in order to protect as much as possible the health and safety of all RISKWORLD 2026, attendees.

- RISKWORLD COVID-19 Vaccination Policy** – Currently, there are no COVID-19 vaccine mandates or requirements in place for RISKWORLD 2026. RIMS will follow all applicable communicable disease vaccination and/or testing requirements in place in the city of Philadelphia. RIMS will communicate the city's requirements to registrants as part of the registration process and will keep registrants informed of any changes to such policies.

- Conference Code of Conduct**- RIMS is dedicated to providing a harassment-free Event experience for everyone, including speakers, sponsors, exhibitors, staff, vendors, and attendees. We do not tolerate unacceptable behavior by conference participants in any form.

“Unacceptable behaviors” include intimidating, harassing, abusive, discriminatory, derogatory or demeaning conduct by any participant at the Event or related events.

“Harassment” includes offensive verbal comments, stalking or following, harassing photography or recording, sustained disruption of talks or other events, or inappropriate physical contact.

If a participant is asked to stop any unacceptable behavior, the participant is expected to comply immediately. If a participant does not comply, he or she may be asked to leave the Event without a refund at the sole discretion of RIMS.

We encourage you to help us create a positive Event environment for everyone and ask you to be mindful of your surroundings and of your fellow participants. Please alert conference staff if you notice a dangerous situation, see someone in distress or have any concerns.

- Prohibited Conduct - Disruptive Conduct.** You acknowledge and agree that RIMS reserves the right to remove you from the Event if RIMS, in its sole discretion, determines that your participation or behavior creates a disruption or hinders the enjoyment of the Event content by other attendees.

Recording, Live Streaming, and Videotaping. Participants may not record or broadcast audio or video of sessions during the Event.

Unethical/Non-Compliant Business Practices. RIMS reserves the right to deny participation to anyone who engages in or is reputed to engage in unethical or non-compliant business practices.

- For the safety of our attendees, the following items are prohibited at RISKWORLD:**

- Firearms (functional and replica)
 - Including airsoft, BB, cap, paintball, pellet, and toy guns
- Weapons (functional and replica)
 - Including knives of any type or size, projectiles, blunt weapons, and chemical substances (such as mace or pepper spray)
- Explosive devices or material
 - Including fireworks of any kind, incendiary devices such as flares, ammunition, or any other dangerous material.

- Including air horns
- Banners or pamphlets
 - Including any material deemed disruptive to the event
- Personal drones or unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs)
- Motorized or non-motorized vehicles
 - Including bikes, skateboards, and scooters
- Anything deemed inappropriate or unsafe for the venue by RIMS, law enforcement, or security personnel

6. Under 21 Registration Code of Conduct

At RISKWORLD 2026, RIMS is committed to maintaining a safe and respectful environment for all participants, including registrants under the age of 21. To ensure that everyone's experience is positive, RIMS has established the following code of conduct for registrants under the age of 21:

- **Alcohol and Substance Use:** Registrants under the age of 21 are expected to comply with all local, state, and federal laws regarding the consumption and possession of alcohol and controlled substances. RIMS prohibits individuals under the age of 21 from consuming or possessing alcohol or controlled substances at any RIMS venue or event.
- **Responsible Behavior:** RIMS expects all registrants, regardless of age, to exhibit responsible and respectful behavior towards fellow attendees and staff. Disruptive or inappropriate conduct, including any form of harassment, will not be tolerated.
- **Under 21 Prohibition at Sunday Opening Reception:** The Sunday Opening Reception for RISKWORLD is strictly for attendees who are 21 years of age or older. Due to local regulations and the service of alcoholic beverages, individuals under the age of 21 will not be permitted to attend the Sunday opening reception.
- **Consequences:**
 - If an attendee violates any of these policies, RIMS reserves the right at its sole discretion to take disciplinary action, up to and including immediate removal from the event and expulsion from the remainder of RISKWORLD.
 - A registrant is attending RISKWORLD in an official capacity on behalf of their college or university and the registrant violates the terms of this policy, RIMS reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to suspend the registrant's college or university from all RISKWORLD activities for a period of up to three years."

By registering and attending RISKWORLD 2026, registrants under the age of 21 agree to abide by these policies and uphold the highest standards of personal conduct. RIMS believes that a respectful and responsible community benefits everyone, and RIMS is dedicated to creating an inclusive and safe environment for every

7. Exhibition Policy/No Suitcasing

Any conference visitor who is observed to be soliciting business in the aisles or other public spaces, in another company's booth, or in violation of any portion of the Rules and Regulations, will be asked to leave immediately. Additionally, penalties may be applied. Please report any violations you may observe to Show Management. Show Management recognizes that suitcasing may also take the form of commercial activity

conducted at an official RIMS sanctioned event. For the purposes of this policy, suitcasing violations may occur at venues other than the exhibition floor and at other events.

8. RIMS Outboarding Policy

BE AWARE. We need Your Help. Our Policy on Outboarding

Outboarding is when non-exhibiting companies host offsite events (meetings, activations) during RISKWORLD. This practice harms the conference, attendees, and official partners by drawing participation away from scheduled activities.

These companies benefit from RISKWORLD without contributing, undermining the investment of our exhibitors and sponsors. Outboarding is unethical.

We ask for your help:

- Decline invitations from non-exhibitors if they conflict with official RISKWORLD events.
- Report violations to RIMS staff.

Protect the integrity of RISKWORLD. Remember, these competing events only exist because of our conference.

9. **Diversity, Equity and Inclusion** - RIMS is driven to empower us all to build a highly diverse, equitable, and inclusive culture of belonging in our global risk community. RISKWORLD is designed to welcome everyone of all backgrounds.

10. **Badge Ethics, Counterfeiting and Theft** - Only persons registered for RISKWORLD and wearing the proper badge will be admitted to RIMS events that take place during RISKWORLD.

Anyone found to be counterfeiting, copying, or sharing conference name badges, or using a guest badge when they are not eligible for a guest badge, may be subject to sanctions up to and including removal from the conference and revocation of RIMS membership.

11. **Badge Reprint** - A US \$250 non-refundable fee will be charged to replace a badge for any reason, including lost or stolen badges.

12. **Photography** - Photographs may not be taken of any sessions except by the press or the official photographer designated by RIMS.

13. **Photo/Video Release** - By registering and participating in the Event, you acknowledge and accept that photographs or videos taken of you by the Risk and Insurance Management Society, Inc. - 14. Video & Hybrid** - Videotaping and hybrid events (including webcams, webinars, and streaming video content) are prohibited inside the Pennsylvania Convention Center unless you have written permission from the RIMS Chief Executive Officer or RIMS Chief Events and Sales Officer. In the event that RIMS authorizes videotaping and use of equipment, videos may not be taken for any exhibitor booth or product other than that of your own company, except by approved press or the official videographer designated by RIMS.
- 15. RIMS Respects Your Privacy**
Mailing List: RIMS provides the attendee mailing list to exhibitors for one-time usage (no emails included). If you wish to be excluded from the mailing list, check the respective box during the registration process.
- 16. Demographic and Contact Information** - Your name, address, phone number, email address, and individual and company demographic information are part of your registration. If you attend a sponsored session/event, you will be releasing your information to that exhibitor/sponsor.

By registering or attending the Event, you give permission for your contact information to be shared with associated third-party vendors and sponsors and be included in the RIMS attendee list.

17. Onsite Registration Policies and Procedures

RIMS accepts American Express, VISA, MasterCard, and corporate/personal/travelers checks payable in US dollars drawn from a US bank for payment of registration fees.

Please note: Onsite registration fees are non-refundable.

Registration materials will be released only to the individual whose name appears on the badge. Photo identification (driver's license or passport) or a credit card will be required. Business cards are not an acceptable form of identification. Badges are non-transferable.

- 18. Membership Status and Pricing** - RIMS will assign the lowest possible registration rate based on your membership status and category. RIMS members must be in good standing (dues are up to date) at the time of registration and at the time of the event. If someone registers as a member and their membership expires prior to the event, RIMS has the right to adjust the registration fee to non-member status and issue a balance due for the difference in member to non-member fees. If a registrant does not renew their membership or pay the non-member rate differential, their registration status will be changed from "confirmed" to "pending." RIMS membership must be valid until May 31, 2026.

Please note: To receive the member rate, you must be an active RIMS member at the start of the conference. Your membership status as of the conference's start date determines the registration fees charged. Membership applications are not processed onsite during the conference.

RIMS reserves the right to adjust registration fees and category or cancel registration if members are no longer eligible to hold the membership category.

Third-member organizational membership discount must meet the qualifying criteria:

- Must maintain two confirmed and active organizational professional members' full conference registration. Discount will be removed for registration not meeting the above qualifying criteria; registration fee will be adjusted with a balance due.

- Advance Registration Rates end February 28, 2026; Regular Rate ends May 2, 2026. Registration deadlines are based on Eastern Time Zone
- Registration processed online beginning May 3, 2026, will be charged the Online Onsite Rate, and registration processed at the registration counter onsite at the Pennsylvania Convention Center will incur a US\$50 processing fee.

19. RIMS Student Registration Policy

- Purpose** - The purpose of this policy is to establish eligibility criteria for individuals applying under the RIMS Student Registration Category. This ensures that all student registrants meet the academic and membership standards set forth by the organization.
- Eligibility Requirements** - To qualify for the Student Registration Category, applicants must meet all of the following requirements:
 - Be a full-time undergraduate student enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester.
 - Be enrolled for the Spring 2026 academic term and submit an official or unofficial Spring 2026 transcript as proof of enrollment.
 - Be pursuing a major in risk management, insurance, business, finance, or management with a demonstrated emphasis in risk management and/or insurance.
 - Not be currently employed in any capacity at the time of application.
 - Provide a valid government-issued photo identification for verification purposes.
 - Maintain an active RIMS Student Membership in good standing until May 31, 2026.
- Verification and Documentation** - Applicants are required to submit all necessary documentation to verify eligibility, including transcripts and identification. RIMS reserves the right to request additional information if needed to confirm eligibility.
- Compliance** - Failure to meet or maintain any of the above requirements may result in denial or revocation of student registration status.
- Policy Enforcement** - RIMS reserves the right to review and enforce this policy at its discretion and to make determinations regarding eligibility on a case-by-case basis.

- Promotional Codes and Discount Codes** - The use of a promo code and a discount code is only valid at the time of the initial purchase or registration. Refunds will not be authorized for existing registrations where the special offer was received after the initial purchase. Discounted registration fees cannot be combined with a discount code to further reduce registration costs. Limit one (1) special offer/reduced fee/discount code per registration.

RIMS will void promotional and discount codes if the registrant is not the authorized user. Registration status will be "pending" until the appropriate fee has been paid. 23. Cancellation and Refunds *

- All registration cancellations must be in writing and emailed to RIMS_Registration@GoEshow.com.
- Cancellation requests for registration without Peace of Mind received before and on January 31, 2026, will receive a full refund minus a US\$250 cancellation fee. Cancellations received after January 31, 2026, are non-refundable.
- Cancellation requests for registration with Peace of Mind received before and on May 02, 2026, will receive a full refund minus the Peace of Mind fee.
- All administrative/processing fees and additional registration items, such as the Opening Reception, Foundation for Risk Management After Party tickets, and Continuing Education Credit, are non-refundable.
- Attendees who do not attend the Event and/or do not contact RIMS via written correspondence during the set window as directed above will be responsible for the full attendee registration fee.

24. Substitution and Downgrade *

25. **RISKWORLD Schedule** - Please register in advance for the sessions and special events that you wish to attend. Although sessions are on a first-come, first-served basis, completing your selections in advance helps RIMS assign each session an appropriately sized room to accommodate all interested participants.

Only individuals registered and badged may attend RISKWORLD events. Attendees must have an appropriate badge to attend educational sessions, breakfasts, lunches, and all networking events.
